

ORDER

Before the court is Defendants’ Motion to Stay Proceedings for 60 Days (Doc 57); and Defendants’ Unopposed Motion for an Extension of Time to File Proposed Summary Judgment Briefing Schedule and to Respond to Union Intervenors’ Motion to Intervene (Doc. 58). Both motions were filed March 17, 2017, and are unopposed. Defendants request a stay of this case for sixty days and request that the court adjourn the deadline for the parties to submit a proposed summary judgment briefing schedule. The court **grants** Defendants’ motions (Docs. 57, 58) and **stays** this case until **June 5, 2017**. The parties’ deadline to submit a proposed summary judgment briefing schedule and Defendants’ response deadline to the motions to intervene is extended to **July 5, 2017**. No further extensions of time will be granted absent good cause.
